



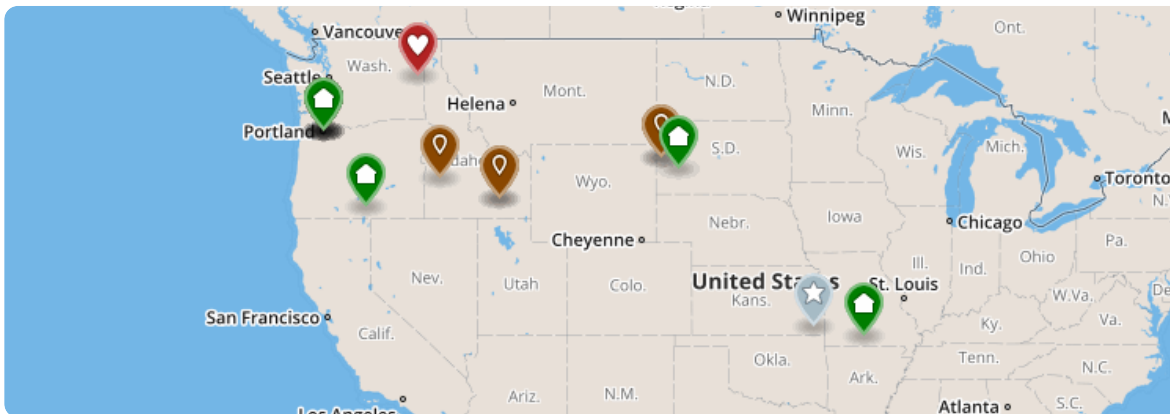
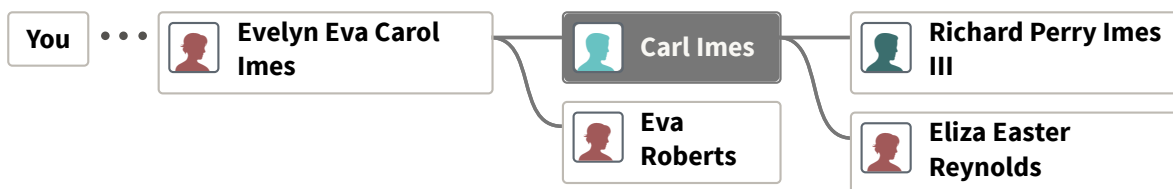

When Carl Imes was born on April 10, 1874, in Parsons, Kansas, his father, Richard, was 33 and his mother, Eliza, was 20. He married Eva Roberts and they had five children together. He then married Mabel Bentley and they had two children together. He died on August 9, 1931, in Portland, Oregon, at the age of 57, and was buried there.

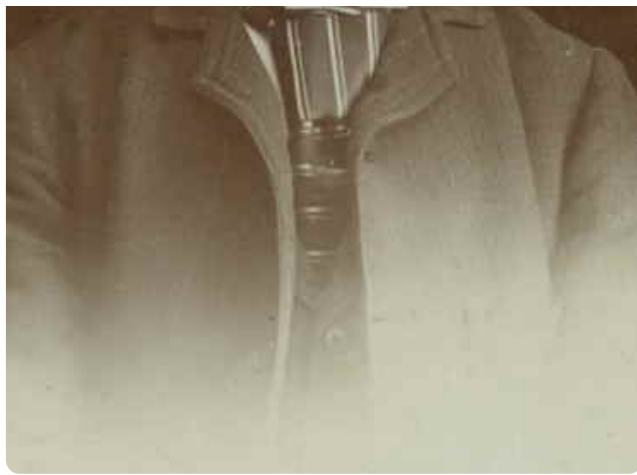

Richard Perry Imes was born November 4, 1878, in Springfield, Mo., the son of Richard Perry Imes and Eliza Esther (Reynolds) Imes. His father, who was of German ancestry, was a farmer and was a scout

and soldier in the Civil War. He has one brother, Carl Imes, a graduate of the South Dakota State Normal School. A sister, Jennie May Imes, is now deceased.

Before entering the School he was graduated from the South Dakota State Normal School and was for two years student assistant in the Division of Forestry.

He was married December 31, 1903, in Lincoln, Neb., to Miss Hanna Charlotte Christiansen of Spearfish, S. Dak., daughter of H. J. Christiansen. They have one son, Richard Perry Imes, born August 24, 1906, in Deadwood, S. Dak., and one daughter, Karen Charlotte Imes, born November 5, 1903, in Ogden, Utah. A daughter, born June 16, 1905, died the same day.

Imes has been continuously in the United States Forest Service since leaving the Yale Forest School. He was forest assistant from 1903 to 1905 and forest inspector from 1905 to 1908. In 1909 he was appointed chief of operation, District 4, and since 1910 he has been supervisor of the Harney National Forest, South Dakota, with headquarters at Custer.

He attends the Congregational church and in politics is a Bull Moose. He is a member of the Masonic Lodge of Custer, S. Dak., and of the Ogden Business Men's Club of Ogden, Utah.

Carl Imes of the forest service, will take advantage of the regular vacation which Uncle Sam grants to all of his employes, to spend Christmas with his family at American Falls. Mr. Imes is the ranger in charge of the Boise river district of the Sawtooth reserve. He was in Boise yesterday. Mr. Imes has been a resident of American Falls for a number of years and is very enthusiastic over the prospects of an early development of the new townsite and the surrounding country. He says that the dry farming habit seems to be taking a deep hold on the people about American Falls, and the area devoted to dry farming is being rapidly increased and that method of farming is meeting with very satisfactory returns.
